## START-UP LIST

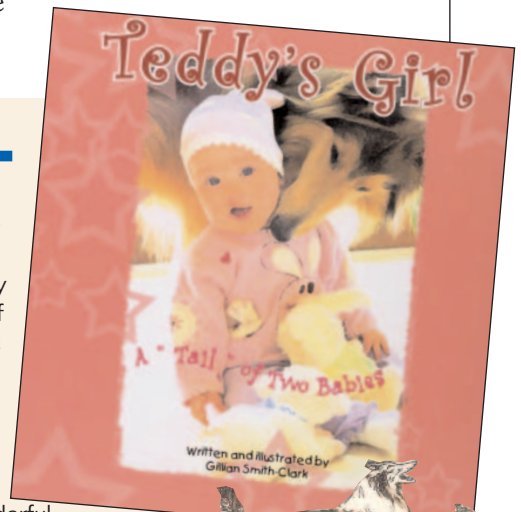
- A veterinarian, and an appointment right away. Most breeder contracts specify that the dog be examined within three working days.
