Entry fee is \$45 for all classes, except dogs who are pre-entered in HIT, those entries are \$35. Each entry fee includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee. Confirmation of entry will be made via e-mail.
- Drawing for run order shall be held at 430 Maryland Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21228 on Thursday, September 8 2011.
- Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone Number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (Visa, MasterCard or Discover) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. # NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Entries close at **6:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 7, 2011** at the Secretary's address (after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Herding Regulations).
  - Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules are not acceptable. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. **Do not send entries requiring a signature upon delivery.** Returned checks, postdated checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Test Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
  - Declination of entries: The CC of A may decline any entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the CC of A or any official thereof.
  - Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No refunds for bitches in season. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.
  - Bitches in season shall be eligible and will be run at the end of their class.
  - There will be no smoking at the show site. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner. Bring shade, water and chair. Event will be held rain or shine.
  - All dogs present which are not being worked in the arena must be kept quiet, off course, on leash and away from the fences. Please do not allow them to disturb the resting stock or interfere with the working dog.
  - Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
  - Exhibition Only Day-of entries will be offered if entries have not reached the numerical limits and must be received by the trial secretary by 8:00 a.m.
- Closing of Entries/Alternates and Move-Ups** (AKC Herding Rules & Regulations, Section 13):
- Whenever trial entry limits have been reached all additional entries that are received prior to the closing date shall be added to an alternate's list for each level that exceeds the published limit(s). This trial will keep an alternate list of five (5) runs. When entries exceed the judge limits and the alternate list, a second judge will be hired and classes will be shifted to accommodate the entries. Exhibitors on the alternate list will then be moved into the trial and notified of the change.
  - Duck entries: Duck entries are limited to 18 runs per day. A five (5) dog alternate list will be kept for duck entries.
  - Entrants on the alternates list must check in with the Herding Secretary on the grounds no later than 30 minutes before the commencement of their class.
  - Entry fee will be refunded to the alternates whose dogs **do not** have an opportunity to run.
  - Requests for move-up must be given to the Herding Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.

Food and drink will be available on site.

## ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS

Open to all Collies nine (9) months of age or older that are registered with The American Kennel Club or have been granted an ILPIPAL and are eligible to compete in herding trials and tests under Chapter 1, Section 3 of the AKC Herding Regulations.

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## DIRECTIONS

Keepstone Farm is located at 412 Russell Road, in scenic Berryville, Virginia; less than a mile from Route 7 West. It is easily accessible from Northern Virginia, West Virginia and Frederick Maryland via major roadways.

From the East: From Leesburg VA, take Route 7 West. Passing 2 traffic lights after the Rt 340 exit for Berryville, turn Right on Russell Road (Rt 660).

\* Go 3/10 mile, turn Right at large Keepstone Farm sign (Dog Gone Healthy sign below). Follow farm lane to Left turn at #412, and go to end of Driveway.

From the West: From I-81, Take Exit 315, Rt 7 East at Winchester VA. Go about 6 miles, and turn Left on Russell Road (Rt 660). Follow \* directions above.

From the North: From Frederick MD, take Rt 340/15 South, bearing right on 340 South at the split. Follow 340 to Charles Town WV, and continue South on 340 to Rt 7 West at Berryville VA. Follow Rt 7 West through 2 traffic lights, to Russell Rd on right. Follow \* directions above.

From the South: From Rt 66 West - Take Rt 17 North toward Paris VA. Take 17 to traffic light, and turn Left onto Rt 50 West toward Winchester. ## HERDING INSTINCT TESTING (HIT)

The Collie Club of America is offering Herding Instinct Testing for dogs who have never been tested or worked on livestock.

The American Kennel Club will issue an Instinct Tested certificate to an eligible dog that has been certified by two different Judges to have qualified by passing two separate licensed or member Herding Instinct Tests.

Test Elements: The dog is brought into the arena on a long line approximately 6-15 feet in length. At some point while on the line, the dog must demonstrate a stop (down, sit or stand) and a recall before the line is dropped or removed. A dog which cannot be recalled shall not be let off line. Dogs must be immediately removed from the ring if physical force is necessary to protect stock from the dog.

Regular entry fees apply. **PRE-ENTRY:** Preferred, please use included AKC herding entry form, and indicate "Herding Instinct Test (HIT)" under the Test Section. To encourage pre-entry of this class, pre-entries are discounted to \$35 per run. **DAY OF SHOW ENTRY:** Available up to the limits of the judge(s). Day of show entry fee is \$45.
