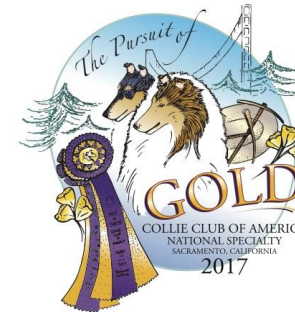

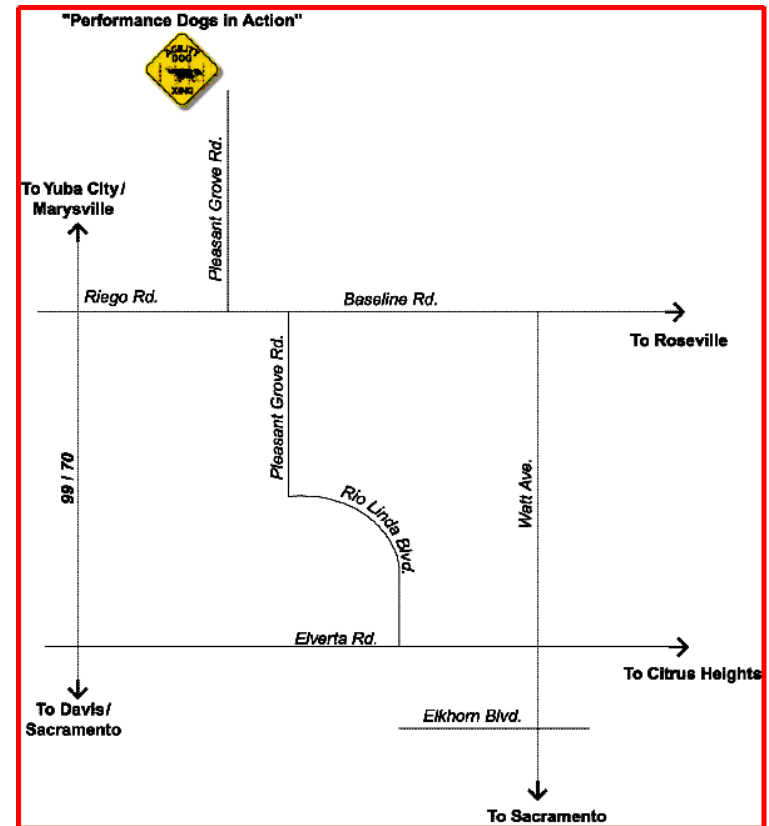

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

From Sacramento: Take 5 North to 99 North. Exit East (right) on Riego Rd. Follow to the 2nd stop sign at Pleasant Grove Road and make a left heading north. Performance Dogs in Action is 1.5 miles up on the left side of the road.

From Roseville: Take Baseline west about 12 miles from Foothills Road. At the Riego Market and stop sign, Baseline Road turns into Riego Road. At the next stop sign, turn North (right) onto Pleasant Grove Road. Continue as above.

AKC Instinct Herding Test Info

"Section 3. Eligibility of Dogs. All dogs nine (9) months of age or older that are registered with The American Kennel Club and have been accepted into the herding program are eligible to participate in herding tests and trials. However, dogs may enter an Instinct test at six months of age."

Please Note:

Any dogs from the Top 20 of 2016 are eligible to be instinct tested at no cost. Instinct testing will be held in conjunction with the Tests/Trials at the herding site on March 18th and 19th.

Collie Club of America Herding Instinct Tests will be offered. This means the dog only has to pass one test. Then a CCA certificate will be awarded (in the mail) and the dog's name and date of passing will be listed in the 2017 yearbook.

Sheep practice runs will be available on March 17. Cost will be \$40 for 10 minutes of practice. Contact Hildy Morgan for more information: hildy.morgan@gmail.com

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Trial Hours: 8:00 AM to completion

Grounds will be available: Saturday 8:00 AM through Sunday until one hour after completion of event.

Method of Entry Entries will be prioritized by a random drawing for each day of receipt. Entries must have clearly visible USPS postmark. Express or overnight entries will be accepted only if signature waived.

Closing Date In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 9 of AKC Dog Show Rules, entries will close on said date or when the limit has been reached, if prior thereto. Entries must be received at the Trial Secretary's address by the published closing date to be acceptable. Incomplete, unsigned, conditionals, telephone, telegraph, or entries received without fees are not acceptable. Entries must be on the enclosed blank or a reasonable facsimile thereof.

Eligibility Open to all AKC Registered Collies including Collies with PAL/ILP Numbers. Collies nine months of age or older, may enter Tests and Trials

Bitches in season shall be eligible and will run at the end of their class in tests and in catalog order in trial classes. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will assess a collection fee of \$35.00 in addition to the amount of each returned check. **Entry fees shall not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent (unless replaced by an alternate), disqualified, excused by a veterinarian, judge or tester or barred from competition by the Show Committee. Any dogs aggressive to persons or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 22 of the *American Kennel Club Herding Rulebook*.) No refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

Dogs must be ready for their classes. Test/Trial judges have the authority to refuse to judge any dog that does not appear within five minutes of being called for its run. The Test/Trial-giving Club and the Test/Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

MOST VERSATILE COLLIE IN THE 2017 NATIONAL SPECIALTY SHOW

To be eligible for this award a Collie must participate in at least three of the four AKC events offered by the CCA (Breed, Obedience/Rally, Agility or Herding). Sign up for the award at any performance event. You must sign up for the award to be eligible, and signup sheets must be turned in to Beth Elliott by the end of the agility trial. The detailed rules for determining the winner from the Collies that qualify for the award are given below. Note that weighting factors are used in each of the performance events to recognize the increased difficulty of the higher level classes. In the Non-Best of Variety classes, points are awarded based on the number of dogs defeated in the class. All scores will be recorded from the posted Judges' sheets Beth Elliott will maintain the official scores at this show. The award presentations will be announced on Saturday, March 25, 2017 in the main conformation ring (Time TBA).

Rules For The Most Versatile Collie Award

To be eligible for this award, your Collie needs a qualifying score in at least three of the four AKC events at the National Specialty. A Collie that receives MVC points in Breed is considered to have received a qualifying score for that event. Only one score will be counted for each event. The Collie obtaining the highest point total will win the award. The following scoring system will apply.

Breed

- All Collies that are a conformation champion or have at least 5 championship points will receive a minimum of 40 MVC points for entering and showing in a conformation class at the CCA national.
- Collies with less than 5 Championship points will not automatically receive any MVC points for showing in a conformation class. Points will only be awarded for placing in a class and defeating competition.
- Since this is an individual award, Brace Class performance does not count. No points will awarded to Collies entering a conformation class and not showing (i.e. marked absent).
- In the BOV class and winners competition, points will awarded as follows:

Making no cuts: 40 points	Reserve Winners: 75 points
Making first cut: 50 points	Winners: 80 points
Making second cut: 60 points	Best of Winners: 85 points
Making third cut: 70 points	BOS to BOV: 90 points
Awards of Merit: 80 points	Best of Variety: 100 points
Select Dog or Bitch: 85 points	

- In all other conformation classes, points will be awarded based on the number of dogs defeated in that class as follows:
 1. No placement 40 points for conformation Champions and Collies with 5 or more Championship points. 0 points for Collies with less than 5 Ch. points.
 2. Placements Two (2) additional MVC points are awarded for every dog defeated in the class up to a maximum total of 70 MVC points. (Collies with less than 5 Ch. points will also receive the base 40 MVC points for placing and defeating dogs in a class).

Herding Test and Trial (No points are awarded for Herding Instinct or Exhibition Only entries)

- Herding Tested Class: Passing: 50 points
- Pre-Trial Tested Class: Passing: 50 points
- Started Trial Class: 90% of total score (out of 100)
- Intermediate Trial Class: 95% of total score (out of 100)
- Advanced Trial Class: 100% of total score (out of 100)

Obedience and Rally Trial (Since this is an individual award, Brace Class Performances do not count.)

- Beginner Novice: 40% of total score (out of 200)
- Preferred Novice: 43% of total score (out of 200)
- Novice and Veteran: 45% of total score (out of 200)
- Graduate Novice: 46% of total score (out of 200)
- Open & Preferred Open: 47% of total score (out of 200)
- Graduate Open: 48% of total score (out of 200)
- Utility & Preferred Utility: 50% of total score (out of 200)
- Rally Novice: 60% of total score (out of 100)
- Rally Advanced: 75% of total score (out of 100)
- Rally Excellent: 90% of total score (out of 100)

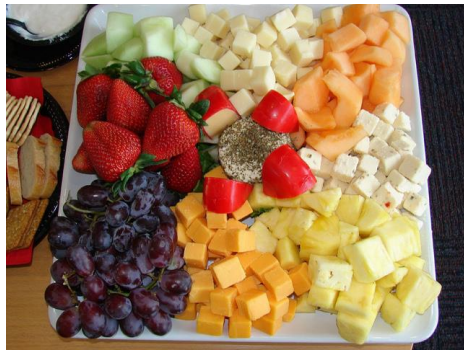

The Collie Club of Connecticut and the Hartford-Springfield Collie Club offer The Lois Russell Perpetual Remembrance to honor a gracious lady in the sport of herding with our beloved breed, the Collie. Lois Russell was instrumental in her efforts resulting in AKC and CCA adopting herding as an event to restore our breed's working heritage. Also, the Collie Club of Connecticut and the Hartford-Springfield Collie Club wish to pay tribute to Lois' ten years of service as Connecticut's District Director.

The annual winner will receive a copy of the bronze composite relief casting of the herding scene mounted on the side of The Lois Russell Perpetual Remembrance to be provided by the Collie Club of Connecticut and the Hartford-Springfield Collie Club.

The winner must be a CCA member owning the Highest Scoring Collie with a qualifying score on sheep from the Course A classes at the national herding trial. In years with multiple trials there will be only one composite relief casting awarded. In the event of a multiple-trial event creating a tie or a one-day event with tie score classes, the winner is to be determined by AKC Herding Regulations, Chapter 4, Section 9, "Ties."
