This is the final confirmation of your entries in the Collie Club of America National Specialty Agility trials.

**Please be sure that your collie is entered in the proper classes and heights.** Let me know if any changes need to be made. Also attached with your confirmation, you will find a document that contains the trial entry statistics and the running order (as of 3/13/18). If you would like a printed copy of the **running order**, please print your own.

Pretrial move ups will be accepted until Monday March 19 at 6 PM in writing. Day to day move ups from Monday to Tuesday will be accepted. If you are entered in the English Setter Association of America's agility trials on the previous Saturday or Sunday (3/24 and 3/25) at the same location, there will be a notebook for CCA move up requests based on titles completed at the ESAA trials. I will be attending the ESAA trials if you have any questions about move ups. Please get those move up requests to the trial secretary within 15 minutes of the end of the last class.

The trials will be held on an indoor climate controlled turf field. There is room for exhibitor and spectator seating at one end of the turf agility field. If you don't have your own chairs, you can use chairs that belong to the facility. General crating is not allowed in this area. Only dogs belonging to the trial secretary and to handicapped handlers will be allowed to crate along the perimeter of this area. Dogs will be brought into this area when they are preparing to go into the ring. Dog treats are allowed in the seating area.

An addition room has been rented for collie crating and for drinks and snacks. Please keep all drinks and human food in the crating room, as it is not allowed in the main turf field area. Please bring a **waterproof covering** to go under your crates. Crates may be left over night, however the CCA and Body Renew Fitness will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

The English Setter's agility trial on Sunday should conclude on Sunday afternoon around 5 PM. If you have competed in that trial and your crates are already set up in the crating room, you may leave them in place. If you would like to set up on Sunday afternoon, please come from 5:30-6:30 PM.

The building will be opened at 7 AM on Monday and Tuesday. Trials will run from **small to tall both days: 16" -20" – 24"** For every class, all heights will walk together for 8 minutes, followed by 5 minutes until the first dog on the line.

MEASURING: There will be at least 2 VMOs at the trial. All dogs without a valid Jump Height Card or Measuring Form must be measured before its first run of the trial. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. You don't have to be there hours before your run, but do not wait until the last minute before you are to run to have your dog measured.

Although there is a concession stand in the facility, it is not scheduled to be open on Monday and Tuesday. There are fast food options nearby, and CCA will provide bottled water, muffins, cookies, chocolate, nuts, trail mix, fruit, cheese and other snacks. There is also a Keurig coffee machine that we can use. Bring your favorite pods and a few extra to share!

Exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs at both the trial site and the hotels. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Dogs can be walked in the field in the front of the building and in the grassy right-of-way between the closed Gander Mountain store and the highway. There will be poop bags and trash containers available. Do not exercise your dog in the back of BRF. This property belongs to another business. NO FLEXLEADS are to be used in the building or near the doors.

RV Parking: RV's may not be parked at the facility overnight or in any of the surrounding businesses' parking lots. During the day, RV's may be parked along the side of the building. They may not be parked in the front of the building.

Your **CCA Welcome bags** will be available for pickup if you have signed up in advance with Judy Guthrie. Also a limited selection of **CCA merchandise** will be available for sale by Leslie Butler on Monday.

*We will need the help of every exhibitor to run these trials!* There is a Google spreadsheet for **Volunteer Workers** at [www.goo.gl/UZHSHC](http://www.goo.gl/UZHSHC). You can select your own job and time to work so that it does not interfere with preparation for your runs. Select the tabs on the bottom to move from day to day. Some of the classes are quite small, so please sign up for 2 or 3 small classes or one large class each day! If you have trouble signing up, just email me and I will enter your selection. There is also a **built-in timeline** for your convenience on the worker sheet. All times are approximate and should be used only as a guide. At the end of the trial on Tuesday, we will need help to break down the rings and move the rented equipment into the MAD Agility truck. If we have enough help, we can do it quickly and head to Virginia Beach for more fun!

MOST VERSATILE COLLIE

You must register to compete for the MVC Award. You can pick up a registration form from Noreen Bennett at the herding trials or from Jim Smotrel at the agility trials. The form must be turned in to Jim Smotrel by the end of the agility trials on Tuesday 3/27. Jim will record the scores from the official CCA postings. The presentation of the MVC Qualifiers and the MVC Winner will be held on Saturday, around lunch time. In order to qualify, the collie must have earned MVC points in at least 3 of the 4 areas of competition at the national – herding, agility, obedience/rally and conformation.

DIRECTIONS TO BODY RENEW FITNESS

From the North or South: From Interstate 81, take exit 310 (Kernstown). Take Route 37 and immediately take Route 11 North about 2/10 of a mile to Commonwealth Court. Turn right and drive to the end of the road. Gander Mountain (closed) is on the right. Body Renew is on the left. Park along the front of the building. When you come into the building, turn right and walk to the turf field.

Body Renew Fitness Rules

No large coolers allowed in facility. No cleats may be worn on the field turf.

A tarp must be placed on the floor underneath your crates.

No food allowed on the turf field. Dog treats are allowed.

Each agility exhibitor may pick up a free commemorative notepad and pen at the trial!
