We are pleased to have the National in March since our average temperature is mid 60s and normal severe weather in Oklahoma arrives April and May.

The Cox Convention Center is located at the crossroads of I-35, I-40 and I-44, Oklahoma City is easy to reach and navigate. The Cox Convention Center Exhibit Halls provide an all in one area for conformation, obedience and rally. The Oklahoma State Fairgrounds provide a wonderful site for Agility and Herding Trials. The Fairgrounds are close by located 6 minutes from the Cox Center.

The Host Hotel – The Renaissance Hotel, 10 North Broadway Avenue, Oklahoma City, OK. Ph: 800-468-357 located across from the Convention Center entrance, this hotel has 258 rooms, 53 suites where pets are allowed. (Deposit Required) Just steps away from Bricktown. The CCA rate is \$121.00/night with a full service restaurant and bar.

The Show Committee is pleased to offer several major hotels accepting dogs located right across the street from the Convention Center in downtown Oklahoma City. The hotels and convention center also provide plenty of parking, including a special area that will be reserved for RV Parking. (Parking Fees Will Apply)

Courtyard By Marriott is also located across the street from the convention center with 200 rooms and also has a full service restaurant. They are also very **dog friendly**.

Colcord Hotel is just steps away from the Convention Center and right across from the new dog park. This luxurious hotel has offered a competitive rate and is also **dog friendly**.

The Sheraton Hotel is located across from the Convention Center. It has been quoted as being affordable, pleasant, comfortable, and having a great staff and a full service restaurant and a tunnel connecting to the Cox Convention Center.

Overflow Hotels There are also many other hotels within a 5 to 10 minute drive with rates from \$60 - 160.00/night. Most will accept dogs.

The Cox Convention Center has 3 loading docks and drive-in access, restrooms scattered throughout the building, several ATM machines, a UPS Store as well as WIFI and T Line access to send the video signal to CCA members throughout the world. The Exhibit Halls open up to have the confirmation ring and grooming all in one room.

Oklahoma City has a large dog exercise area across from the show site in the Myriad Botanical Gardens. The grounds are well landscaped with lawns and mature trees and benches for relaxing. The Convention Center is within steps of Bricktown, a popular area with over 30 restaurants and fast food for dining, set on the Bricktown Canal.

The New Devaon Tower will feature a restaurant situated at the top with a view of Oklahoma City while dining.

Airport:The Will Rogers World Airport is located 9 minutes from the hotels and show site. Airlines include American, Delta, Frontier, Continental, United, and Southwest Airlines with many non-stop destinations.

Oklahoma City has a wonderful variety of attractions - many very close to the Convention Center. One of the premier areas is the Bricktown Entertainment District that has experienced tremendous growth in the past year.* Take time to experience Oklahoma City! There are also numerous other venues around the city with many popular attractions:

Bricktown – East of the Cox Convention Center, downtown

Renovated warehouse district, which is now Oklahoma City's hot spot featuring many restaurants and night spots, as well as the Bricktown Canal and the SBC Bricktown Ballpark, home of the Oklahoma City Red Hawks.

Frontier City Theme Park – 1-35 North, Exit 122nd Street

Stroll through an authentic 1880s western town and enjoy over 75 rides, shows, games and attractions. Four thrilling coasters, the Renegade Rapids river raft ride, the perilous Tomahawk and MindBender, and the Mystery River Log Flume. Try The Hangman, a thrilling freefall ride!

Myriad Botanical Gardens – 100 Myriad Gardens, Reno & Robinson The Myriad Botanical Gardens is a 17-acre oasis in the heart of downtown Oklahoma City, with beautifully landscaped rolling hills surrounding a sunken lake. The centerpiece of the gardens is the seven-story Crystal Bridge Tropical Conservatory, featuring a fascinating collection of palm trees, flowers and exotic plants from across the globe.

National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum – 1700 NE 63rd

The National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum preserves the rugged individualism and romantic spirit of the frontier. This popular visitor attraction features a superlative collection of classic and contemporary Western art, including works by Charles Russell, Frederic Remington, and the famous 18-foot sculpture, The End of the Trail. There are three new historical galleries, the American Cowboy Gallery, the American Rodeo Gallery, and Prosperity Junction, a recreated authentic western town.

Oklahoma City Museum of Art – 415 Couch Drive

The new Oklahoma City Museum of Art in the Donald W. Reynolds Visual Arts Center is a 110,000 sq. ft. facility featuring 15 exhibition galleries, an education center, a 250-seat theater, cafe, store and library/resource center. The commissioned 55 ft. signature sculpture by world renowned glass artist Dale Chihuly serves as a beacon for the museum, and downtown.

Oklahoma City Zoo – 2101 N E 50th

Oklahoma City Zoo is home to over 1,500 of the world's most exotic animals, including over 50 endangered or threatened species. Enjoy dramatic views of the world's most exotic animals in naturalistic settings like Great EscApe, Cat Forest/Lion Overlook and The Noble Aquatic Center.

Omniplex – 2100 NE 52nd

Omniplex is an adventure in discovering new worlds and galaxies, exploring the sciences and arts, reliving the past and peering into the future. The complex houses several museums, a planetarium, galleries, gardens and greenhouses. Several museums are all located in the Omniplex, including the Kirkpatrick Science and Air Space Museum, Red Earth Indian Center, and the International Photography Hall of Fame and Museum.
